By providing access to water, improving sanitation and building the necessary facilities, the ICRC met the needs of some 9.9 million people across 45 countries.

ECONOMIC SECURITY

The ICRC distributed food to more than 4.9 million needy people in 54 countries. Hygiene items, cooking utensils, fuel and other aid was provided for 4.7 million people.

In all, 3.2 million people benefited from food-production programmes and micro-economic initiatives.

HEALTH SERVICES

Over 5.2 million people received health care from 294 ICRC-supported hospitals and 351 other medical facilities backed by the organization. ICRC physical rehabilitation programmes in 81 specialized centres helped a total of some 200,945 people in 26 countries.

PROTECTING DETAINEES

ICRC delegates visited 500,928 detainees, at some 1,783 places of detention in 71 countries. The main aim of these periodic visits is to assess the treatment of detainees and the conditions of detention.

RESTORING FAMILY LINKS

The ICRC collected and delivered 305,452 "Red Cross messages" throughout the world, enabling people separated from their loved ones by conflict to stay in touch. In addition, the organization successfully traced 3,822 people and reunited 1,250 of them – almost all minors – with their loved ones.
