SECTION 1: ICRC 2007 HEADQUARTERS APPEAL

THE ICRC 2007 HEADQUARTERS APPEAL PRESENTS THE FOLLOWING FIGURE:

Headquarters Appeal:	CHF 159.9 million

This represents an **increase of CHF 6.0 million (+ 3.9 %)** as compared to the 2006 Headquarters Appeal.

THE ICRC 2007 EMERGENY APPEALS PRESENT THE FOLLOWING FIGURES:

Emergency Appeals:	CHF 843.3 million which includes a contingency of CHF 40.2 million.

This represents a **decrease of CHF 52.0 million (- 5.8 %)** as compared to the *initial* 2006 Emergency Appeals i.e. the original (initial) appeal not including any additional budget extensions that occurred during the year.

EMERGENCY APPEALS 2007 - COMPARATIVE INCREASES AND DECREASES

AFRICA

- → -46.9 mio or -12% compared to initial budget 2006
- → Significant increases include: Chad (+8.5 mio or +99%); Congo, Democratic Republic of the (+3.9 mio or +13%); Uganda (+3.5 mio or +17%); Yaoundé (regional) (+3.2 mio or +70%)
- → Significant decreases include: Sudan (-54.5 mio or -43%); Liberia (-5.3 mio or -20%); Angola (-3.2 mio or -25%); Guinea (-2.2 mio or -26%)

ASIA & THE PACIFIC

- → -57.5 mio or -25% compared to initial budget 2006
- → Significant increases include: Sri Lanka (10.4 mio or +67%); Afghanistan (+9.1 mio or +23%); Philippines (+1.9 mio or +41%)
- → Significant decreases include: Pakistan (-71.5 mio or -74%); Myanmar (-7.0 mio or -48%); Nepal (-2.9 mio or -26%)

EUROPE & THE AMERICAS

- → -6.4 mio or -5% compared to initial budget 2006
- → Significant increases include: Colombia (+3.8 mio or +15%); Brussels (+1.5 mio or +71%); London (+0.4 mio or +112%)
- → Significant decreases include: Moscow (regional) (-6.0 mio or -18%); Georgia (-3.5 mio or -27%)

MIDDLE EAST & NORTH AFRICA

- → +61.2 mio or +60% compared to initial budget 2006
- → Significant increases include: Israel, Occupied and Autonomous Territories (+28.2 mio or +66%); Iraq (+18.0 mio or +47%); Lebanon (+10.5 mio or +614%, but compared to the current 2006 budget, there is a huge decrease: -89.0 mio or -88%)
- → No decreases
