

Key Data for ICRC Emergency and Headquarters Appeals 2005 including comparative data with 2004 figures

1.1 The ICRC Appeals 2005 present the following figures:

- **Headquarters Appeal: CHF 152.1 million** (USD 127 million / EURO 99.5 million) This is similar to the 2004 Headquarters budget of CHF 149.8 million.
- Emergency Appeals: CHF 819.7 million (USD 684.2 million / EURO 536.5 million) which includes a contingency of CHF 39 million.

This represents an **increase of CHF 65 million (+ 8.61 %)** as compared to the *initial* 2004 Emergency Appeals i.e. the original (initial) appeal not including any additional budget extensions that occurred during the year.

1.3 The Emergency Appeals – Comparative Increases and Decreases:

Africa: +83m or +27% compared to 2004

Significant increases include: Sudan (+84m or +181.4%); Uganda (+13.9m or +206.8%); Abidjan Regional (+2.9m or +23.1%); and a new delegation in Chad (7.1m)

Decreases include: Democratic Republic of Congo (-12.9m or -30.3%); Angola (-7.4m or -36.6%); Rwanda (-3.8m or -19.5%)

• Europe & the Americas: -11.9m or -7.8% compared to 2004

There are no significant increases but there is now a new operational delegation in Haiti (CHF 5m)

Decreases include: Serbia & Montenegro (- 7.6m or - 39%); Skopje Regional (-1.1m or -35.8%); Mexico Regional (-1.3m or -19%)

Asia & the Pacific: +4.6m or +3.5% compared to 2004

Increases include: Nepal (+2.5m or +33.3%); Pakistan (+1.2m or +27.2%); New Delhi regional delegation (+1.5m or +23.7%); Tashkent regional delegation (+1.7m or +19.8%); Bangkok regional delegation (+1.1m or +9.8%);

Decreases include: Afghanistan (-3.9m or -8.2%)

Middle East & North Africa: -13.7m or -10.6% compared to 2004

Increases include:

Israel, the occupied and autonomous territories (+6.6m or +16.2%);

Decreases include: Iraq (-20.9m or -30%)

1.4 Breakdown per programme of the overall Emergency Appeals 2005

Note that the budgeted amount for Assistance programmes accounts for more than half the amount of the appeals.
