SECTION 1: ICRC HEADQUARTERS APPEAL 2013

THE ICRC HEADQUARTERS APPEAL 2013 AMOUNTS TO: CHF 186.8 million

This represents an **increase of CHF 6.0 million** (+ **3.3%**) compared with the initial Headquarters Appeal 2012.

SECTION 2: ICRC EMERGENCY APPEALS 2013

THE ICRC EMERGENCY APPEALS 2013 AMOUNT TO:

CHF 988.7 million

This represents a **increase of CHF 19.3 million** (+ **2.0%**) compared with the *initial* Emergency Appeals 2012, i.e. the amount initially appealed for, not including any additional budget extensions that occurred during the year.

EMERGENCY APPEALS 2013 – COMPARATIVE INCREASES AND DECREASES

AFRICA

- → + CHF 25.2 million or + 6% compared with the initial 2012 budget
- → significant increases include: South Sudan (+ CHF 31.8 million or + 128%); Niamey (regional) (+ CHF 15.2 million or + 68%); Mauritania (+ CHF 1.8 million or + 44%)
- → significant decreases include: Sudan (- CHF 15.6 million or 29%); Libya (- CHF 4.7 million or 23%); Abidjan (regional) (- CHF 3.6 million or 21%); Chad (- CHF 1.5 million or 12%)

It also includes 1 new operation: Mauritania² (budget: CHF 5.8 million)

ASIA AND THE PACIFIC

- → CHF 41.6 million or 18% compared with the initial 2012 budget
- → significant increases include: Myanmar (+ CHF 2.7 million or + 54%); Suva (regional) (+ CHF 0.8 million or + 18%)
- → significant decreases include: Pakistan (- CHF 45.3 million or 68%); Sri Lanka (- CHF 0.9 million or 15%)

EUROPE AND THE AMERICAS

- → + CHF 0.9 million or + 1% compared with the initial 2012 budget
- → significant increases include: Mexico City (regional) (+ CHF 3.6 million or + 35%); Caracas (regional) (+ CHF 0.3 million or + 17%)
- → significant decreases include: Kyrgyzstan (- CHF 1.6 million or 15%); Ankara (- CHF 0.8 million or - 100%); Western Balkans (regional) (- CHF 0.3 million or - 7%)

MIDDLE EAST

- → + CHF 34.8 million or + 18% compared with the initial 2012 budget
- → significant increases include: Syrian Arab Republic (+ CHF 38.2 million or + 294%); Lebanon (+ CHF 3.5 million or + 46%); Jordan (+ CHF 1.9 million or + 43%)
- → significant decreases include: Israel and the Occupied Territories (- CHF 5.7 million or 11%); Yemen (- CHF 3.5 million or 9%)
