The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) in the DRC promotes respect for international humanitarian law focusing on the treatment of civilians and detainees and helps those adversely affected by conflict and internal violence to become self-sufficient, often in collaboration with the Congolese Red Cross. We also improve water provision and sanitation, reunite families and strengthen health care services for the wounded and sick, including victims of sexual violence.
