To support the access to **health** and surgical care the ICRC has:



Performed nearly **3,900** surgeries Conducted more then **76,000** outpatient consultations Provided medical materials to **75** first-aid and other healthcare facilities

Provided antenatal care for **3,200** women, safe deliveries for **210** and more than **5,500** vaccine doses for children under one year old

Assisted nearly **1,800** people with disabilities Evacuated **455** war wounded

To help build the **resilience** of displaced people and communities affected by the conflict the ICRC and the South Sudan Red Cross (SSRC) have:



Distributed more than **680,000** food rations Provided household essentials for **90,000** people Provided nearly **300,000** people with seeds and tools for farming and over **90,000** with fishing kits



Vaccinated over **512,000** heads of livestock Treated **90,000** animals, benefitting over **180,000** people Trained **192** community animal health workers and provided them with drugs



Ensured access to safe drinking water for over **192,000** people through the rehabilitation of **173** water points Installed emergency water units benefitting **55,000** people in response to the cholera outbreak

Through visits to places of **detention**, the ICRC supports the authorities to adhere to international standards;



Visited **4,400** detainees throughout the country Improved living conditions for **2,500** detainees and implemented preventive measures against cholera

To help reconnect family members separated by the conflict the ICRC and SSRC have:



Facilitated **14,000** phone calls between family members separated by the conflict Distributed more than **3,000** Red Cross messages

Reunited **26** children and vulnerable people with their families.

To promote knowledge and respect for International Humanitarian Law, the ICRC has:



Trained **1,160** weapon bearers from both sides of the conflict on IHL and **321** weapon bearers, police and fire fighters in first aid and safe access to health care
