The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) is an impartial, neutral, and independent organization whose exclusively humanitarian mission is to protect the lives and dignity of victims of war and internal violence and to provide them with assistance. It also endeavors to prevent suffering by promoting and strengthening humanitarian law and universal humanitarian principles.

The ICRC office in Gaza is looking for candidates to fill in the following position:

Function	: Water and Habitat Engineer (Mechanical Engineer)
Place of employment	: Gaza - Rafah
Occupation rate	: Full time
Type of Contract	: Temporary
Expected Starting Date	: ASAP

Main Tasks:

- Draws up documents (drawings, bills of quantities, contracts, etc.) for engineering projects using approved formats; monitors project implementation for compliance with project documents, ICRC standards, and local building codes/standards, ensuring corrective action is taken where necessary.
- Supervises contractors working on project sites and conducts quality control of infrastructure installed by the ICRC.
- Creates project files in electronic databases (such as the WatHab Project Assistant application) and keeps them up to date.
- Prepares implementation/progress reports.
- Provides regular information to colleagues on security, stakeholder issues and site progress.
- Manages project purchasing on labor and materials according to the delegation's financial and logistical rules.
- Administers hand-over of ICRC-provided infrastructure to end-users.
- Trains and organizes training for end-users in the operation and maintenance of infrastructure installed by the ICRC.
- Uses results-based management to evaluate project implementation.
- Helps identify needs through assessments and surveys.

Education and professional experience requirements:

- University degree in mechanical engineering or related field or similar.
- Minimum 3-5 years' professional experience in a related field of activity (construction of water/wastewater network, generators maintenance/installation)
- Familiar with relevant industry standards and regulations
- Experience in mechanical design, development, and testing
- Knowledge of manufacturing processes and materials selection
- Strong analytical skills and ability to perform complex calculations and simulations.
- Excellent command (spoken and written) of English.
- Proficient in use of drawing software if working in construction and hydraulic engineering.
- Proficiency in CAD software (e.g. SolidWorks, AutoCAD), other engineering tools, MS project-management suite or equivalent.
- Strong local network within administrative interlocutors and the private sector.

- Copy of the highest academic degree obtained and relevant work certificates.
