It also endeavors to prevent suffering by promoting and strengthening humanitarian law and universal humanitarian principles.

The ICRC office in Gaza is looking for candidates to fill in the following position:

Function	: Economic Security Generalist 1
Place of employment	: Gaza - Rafah
Occupation rate	: Full time
Type of Contract	: Temporary
Expected Starting Date	: May 2024

Main Tasks:

Economic Security Generalist 1 carries out basic field and office work related to implementing and monitoring the ICRC's economic security (EcoSec) programme under the close supervision and guidance of their hierarchical superior.

Generalist responsibilities:

- Prepares material and logistics for trips into the field.
- Collects field and other data using data-collection tools and devices.
- Enters data into the survey database and the EcoSec Programme Management Tool (EPMT).
- Maintains and updates databases. Provides verbal reports after field visits.
- Participates in providing assistance to the population (registration, aid distribution, etc.).
- Provides administrative support.

Education and professional experience requirements:

- university degree in a related field.
- Excellent command of English.
- Computer proficiency.
- 3 to 5 years of overall professional experience in a similar field.
