Water to 135,000 people including host communities and IDPs from Mosul and its outskirts was made available as a result of rehabilitating and constructing different water supply systems



Food Parcels to 134,800 people was distributed, each food parcel meets the basic food needs of a family of six for one month



Essential Household Items to 111,000 people including blankets, kitchen sets, basic cookware, jerry cans, kerosene stoves, and buckets



Health Care to 350,000 people through support to primary health care centers and hospitals with medicines, equipment, furniture, incentives, capacity building, dressing kits, weapon-wounded kits, and first aid training



Visits to 27,000 Detainees ensuring proper treatment and living conditions and exchanging 3,131 greetings (salamats) between them and their families



Risk Awareness Sessions to 2300 people including IDPs in camps and residents of retaken areas on remnants of war risk.
