IMPROVING THE TREATMENT OF DETAINEES

- In 2017, 96 detention visits to 38 places of detention were carried out by the ICRC staff.
- Over <u>360 detainees</u> were followed up individually.
 - Up to 68 rounds of assistance, consisting of the most essential items for everyday use by detainees, were distributed to 32 places of detention.
- Around 600 family members were provided with support to cover their travel costs to visit their detained relatives held in places of detention located far from their home.
 Around 303 detainees were visited by their relatives thanks to the Family Visit Assistance Programme.

Prison Management

- **Regulation for the Probation Service and Regulation for the Rehabilitation work** were elaborated by the experts of the State Service for Execution of Punishments (SSEP) with support of the ICRC's Prison System Adviser.
- Overall, over 420 staff of the State Service for the Execution of Punishments (SSEP) participated in the ICRC's trainings and seminars:
 - \Rightarrow UN Bangkok rules for the treatment of female detainees;
 - \Rightarrow Improving of communication skills and Training for trainers;
 - \Rightarrow Seminars for the SSEP's Registration Service;
 - \Rightarrow International standards of treatment of detainees in prison management;









HEALTHCARE IN DETENTION

- At the beginning of 2017, 194 detainees started tuberculosis treatment in three penal institutions of Kyrgyzstan. In December 2017, 208 detainees received tuberculosis treatment under the ICRC's supervision.
- Nearly 5,660 detainees were screened for TB in eight detention facilities.
- Over 1,000 detainees and staff of the penal institutions participated in sessions and competitions organized by the ICRC's medical team for the World Tuberculosis Day.
- Over 60 doctors and nurses from penal institutions participated in trainings on tuberculosis treatment.

IMPROVING CONDITIONS OF DETENTION

- Overall, living conditions in five places of detention have been improved thanks to renovation of infrastructure supported by the ICRC.
 - Big projects accomplished in December 2017:
 - \Rightarrow Construction of medical unit in the Penal Institution-2 for women;
 - ⇒ Renovation of two barracks with lighter conditions of detention in the Penal Institution-19 for life-sentenced detainees;
 - Five penal institutions are following systematic maintenance for spare parts and construction materials with the ICRC support.
 - **45 staff members and management** of penal institutions under the SSEP participated in maintenance seminars.

ENHANCING EMERGENCY REPAREDNESS

- Over 300 community leaders in Jalal-Abad and Batken provinces received First Aid trainings organised by the Red Crescent Society of Kyrgyzstan (RCSK) with the ICRC support.
- 40 members of the RCSK National Disaster Response Team participated in the simulation exercise together with Ministry of Emergency, Ministry of Interior, Ministry of Health and local authorities in Osh province.
- 11 forensic experts from the Ministry of Emergency, Republican Forensic Bureau, Ministry of Interior and the RCSK enhanced their expert skills during a 4-day workshop on Dead Body Management facilitated by the ICRC.

PROMOTING IHL

- Over 170 officers from the Armed Forces and Ministry of Interior learned more about activities of the ICRC, the RCSK and IHL through courses and dissemination sessions in Bishkek and Osh.
- A team of 3 students from Kyrgyzstan participated in the Martens Moot Court Competition, leading to their deeper understanding of IHL.
- A young IHL researcher from Kyrgyzstan took part in the 10th International Conference for Young Researchers on IHL in Yerevan, Armenia as a speaker.
