ICRC HUMANITARIAN RESPONSE IN SOUTH SUDAN: KEY FACTS AND FIGURES

Across the 10 states of South Sudan, we respond to humanitarian needs caused by conflict and armed violence. We help affected communities to rebuild their livelihoods and increase their resilience together with the South Sudan Red Cross. We maintain a dialogue with armed actors to improve their understanding of humanitarian law and how they can prevent human suffering.

EMERGENCY NEEDS

Distributed more than **3,441** tons of food to **262,800** people

Provided essential items (tarpaulins, blankets, sleeping mats, mosquito nets, buckets kitchen sets) to **160,810** people.

Supported South Sudan Red Cross teams to distribute essential items to over **21,000** people affected by seasonal floods



REBUILDING LIVES AND LIVELIHOODS

Distributed seeds and farming tools to **416,344** people

Vaccinated **576,821** heads of livestock benefitting **176,040** people and donated **28** veterinary kits to community animal health workers

Provided fishing kits to **154,632** people



IMPROVING ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE AND WATER

Provided **305,035** consultations at **22** primary health care centres and **1** hospital supported by ICRC

Helped **2,504** people living with physical disabilities receive **2,853** physiotherapy sessions including **545** new clients.

Constructed **66** new water points to help improve access to safe water for **100,000** people



RECONNECTING AND REUNITING FAMILIES

Facilitated **58,330** phone calls between family members separated by the conflict and armed violence.

Reunited **104** vulnerable persons, including children, with their families after they were separated by conflict and armed violence.



VISITING PLACES OF DETENTION AND ASSISTING PEOPLE DEPRIVED OF THEIR LIBERTY

Visited over **5,100** detainees at **34** places of detention to monitor their treatment and helped improve their living conditions

Facilitated release of **1** person deprived of their liberty in our role as a neutral intermediary.



RESPONDING TO COVID-19

Donated hand pump spare parts to nine South Sudan Red Cross branches, to help them to repair **150** hand pumps to improve access to safe water for **75,000** people.

Supported **900** volunteers of South Sudan Red Cross at **16** branches to reach over **2.8** million people with health education and hygiene promotion messages across South Sudan

Prepositioned personal protective equipment for health workers at **22** primary health care centers, **3** hospitals, **3** physical rehabilitation centers and **7** places of detention.

Installed handwashing points and donated soap to **24** places of detention, **22** primary health care centers and **3** hospitals.
