

Digital Platform

+ 150,000 logins on the Safer Access Platform in 2022, which maps risk situations. It was seen by the partners as an element supporting the units communication.

(INCREASE OF 14% IN RELATION TO 2021)

Since its implementation in 2019, the Platform has reached over **419,567** and has **2,561** active users.

Also, in the same period, the Platform received

+ 5,000 risk notifications from

772 active units in the system

1,958 notifications from **education partners**

3,332 notifications from **health partners**.

In 2022

- **Annual Network Meeting** was held with the participation of **92 members**, including local authorities who presented their actions for the sustainability of the Program in their institutions.
- **37 workshops** for Training of Trainers and Refreshments.
- **42 strategic meetings** regarding sustainability and advocacy
