PEOPLE

have access to safe water as a result of rehabilitation and construction of **7** water supply systems.



3,543
RED CROSS MESSAGES

and **15,804** oral messages were exchanged between detainees and their relatives to help them stay in touch.



638
WEAPON BEARERS

attended ICRC training and information activities to increase their understanding of International Humanitarian Law and International Human Rights Law.



28,479
PEOPLE

contacted the ICRC's Community Contact Centre to share feedback on their humanitarian needs and ICRC activities .



302,094
CONSULTATIONS

were performed in **16** ICRC-supported Primary Health Care Centres, while **5,537** new and existing maternity cases were followed. Moreover, **33,558** growth monitoring consultations were carried out for children.



20,822
PEOPLE

with disabilities received physical rehabilitation services, including the fitting of **2,380** prostheses, **17,164** orthoses and **535** wheelchairs, at **15** state-run physical rehabilitation facilities supported by the ICRC and one ICRC-managed centre.



8,380
PEOPLE

were trained on risk awareness and safe behaviour practices related to explosive hazards.



54,919
DETAINEES

were visited in **64** places of detention to ensure proper treatment and living conditions.



75,163
PEOPLE

benefited from the multi-purpose cash, cash for work, and unconditional cash grant, micro economic initiatives and vocational training programs.



24,162
PEOPLE

benefited from food and essential household items distributions.

ICRC RESPONSE, 2020



SUPPORT TO HEALTH FACILITIES

147 health facilities were supported with emergency or regular donations that included medication, equipment, personal protective equipment (PPE) and hygiene materials.

144 oxygenated beds in addition to 33 oxygen concentrators were provided to hospitals to increase their COVID-19 bed capacity for moderate and severe cases.

2.3 million surgical masks and more than 1 million pair of gloves were donated.



ECONOMIC SECURITY SUPPORT

35,175 people were provided with food and essential household items (EHI).

52,957 people received multi-purpose cash assistance (MPCA), cash for work, or unconditional cash grants.

SUPPORT TO DETAINEES

32 detention facilities holding about 49,000 detainees provided with soap, disinfectant, PPE, non-touch thermometers and posters on COVID-19 awareness.

52,082 detainees received assistance, including essential hygiene items, clothing and books.

18,297 detainees have better access to health care in 6 detention facilities.



WATER & HABITAT SUPPORT

256 hand-washing points were installed in 35 health facilities and places of detention.

10,229 vulnerable persons were supported with water filters and jerrycans to increase access to safe water and improve environmental sanitation.

903 families (5,500 individuals) of operators of Mosul city's water services were supported with food parcels.
