


NAIROBI REGIONAL LOGISTICS SUPPORT CENTRE (LSC)



SHIPMENT TO OTHER COUNTRIES

Shipped 10'835 metric tonnes of goods in 2022 to 45 countries with a global value of 35,2 million CHF. Most goods were destined for Africa.

PARTNERSHIPS
