According to the Kenyan authorities, over 4. 35 million people living mostly in Arid and Semi-Arid Lands (ASAL) face severe food insecurity. The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) Working with the Kenya Red Cross (KRCS) targeted its drought response to four main counties in the Coast and North-eastern areas (Lamu, Garissa, Wajir, Mandera). Over 60,000 people have been reached with different types of assistance.
